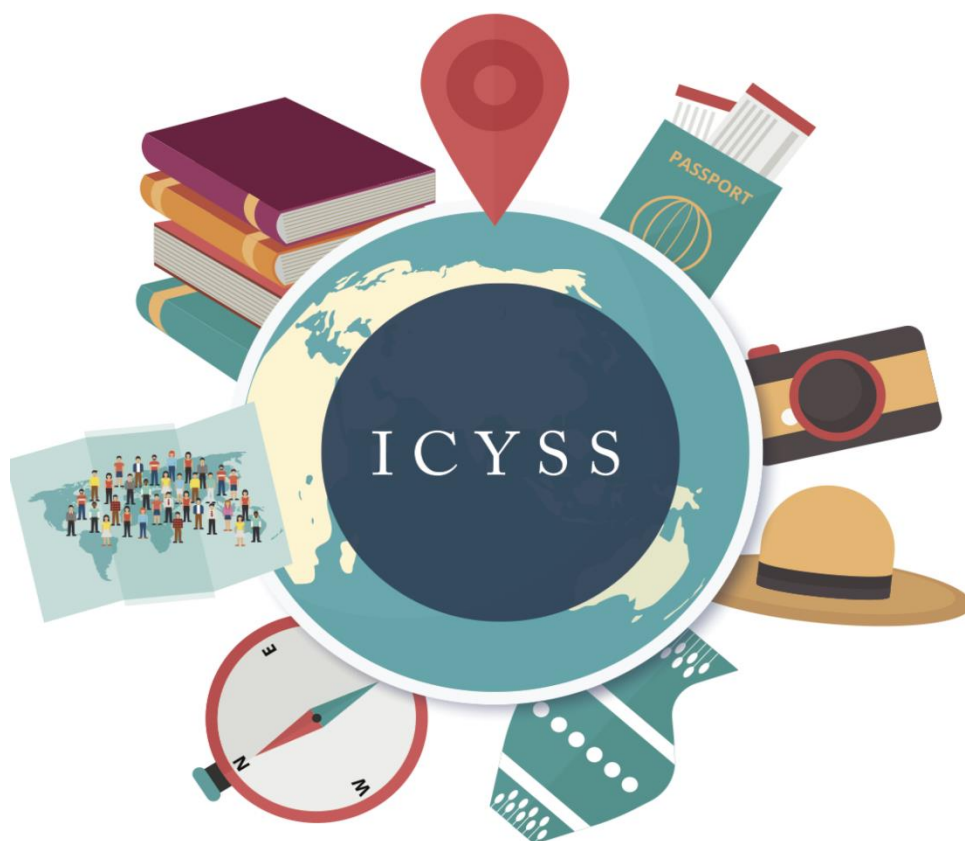

## REGIONAL CENTER FOR TALENTED YOUTH BEOGRAD II

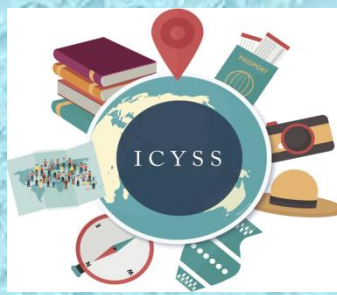

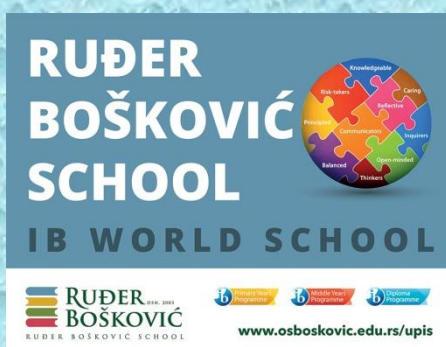

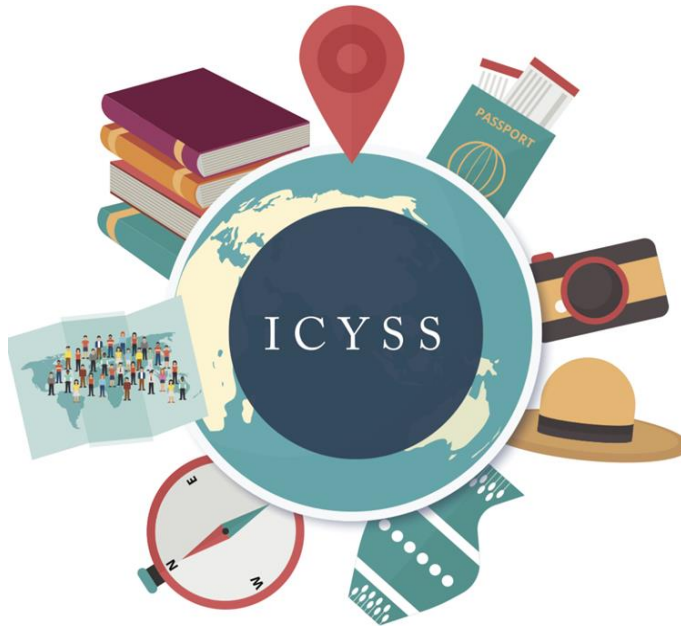

Such competitions have the relevance of student learning:

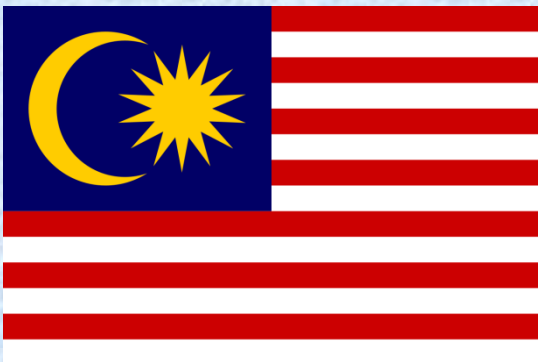
- to do research work,

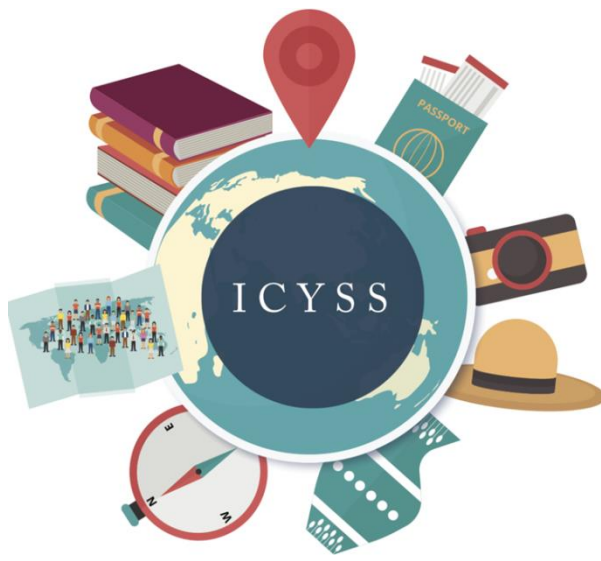

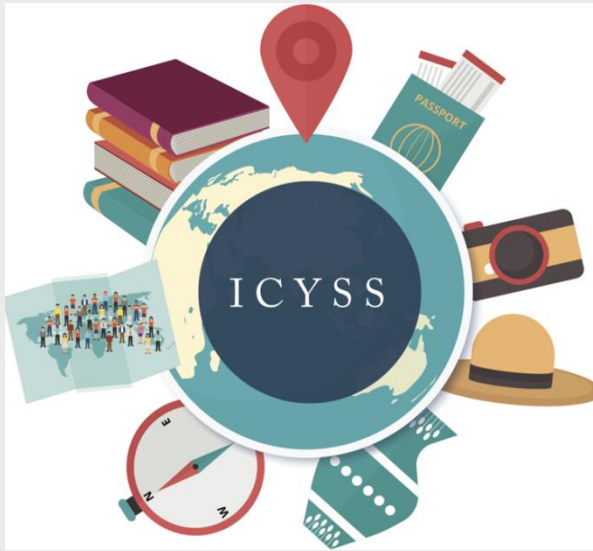

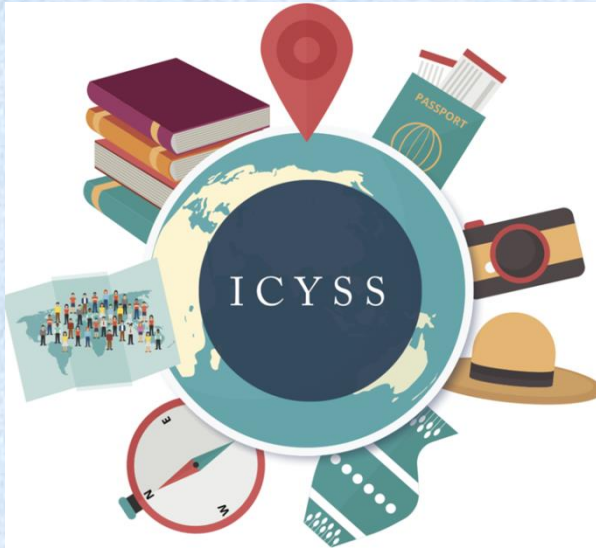
